UPDATE ON ONTARIO CELL PHONE LAW

September 30, 2009 – Today the Ontario Government announced that October 26, 2009 is the date that the new Cell-Phone and Hand Held devices law, prohibiting the use of such devices while driving, will come into effect.

The Ontario government also announced that police officers will be handing out warnings during the period of October 26, 2009 and January 31, 2010. Starting on February 1, 2010 charges in the form of Traffic Tickets will be issued with fines up to \$500.
